Directions for K20 Video Conference Connection

A video conference is a live broadcast of an event being held at a host site and broadcast to participating sites at individual districts and/or ESDs over the K20 system. When you participate via video conference this means you stay in your district & watch the broadcast from there.

- Register using registration form and check "I will attend via video conference." This is all you need to do. There is no need for you or your tech person to contact anyone else.
- Verify that your district's K-20 system is working. Notify your technical staff of the conference and instruct them to confirm the invitation when received. Your technical staff does not need to contact anyone else. If they have not received an invitation by 10 days prior to the video conference then you need to contact scarmichael@wsrmp.com. You will not receive an invitation to the video conference unless you register and check the "I will attend via video conference" box.
