This presentation will cover the recent FMLA changes and update public employers on Washington discrimination law. We will explore the recent changes to the American with Disabilities Act (ADA), including the 2008 amendments to the Act, and recent U.S. Supreme court cases affecting the way the Act is implemented, and how the changes in these three areas of the law will affect public employers immediately and in the future.
